Message: As of March 2019, we are on budget with our expenses and our income. Note that this includes the income from the enchilada sale (\$948), the income from the preschool (\$1500.00), and the income from Weight Watchers rental (\$715.00). Please note that in total we have collected 27199.66. This means that almost 12% of
