UNDER CONSTRUCTION – Church improvements are underway!

We wanted to take a moment and let people know that a number of Church upgrades and improvements are already underway as a result of the receipt of funds from the Sittig estate. We signed a contract for the new heating and air conditioning system for the sanctuary and work is already starting on that project. The new awnings over the two church entrances will be installed the week of November 6-10, and the new flooring is going to be installed on November 3-4.

Those were the first three main improvement projects slated to be done, and we're still looking at other areas and ways we can improve the access and usability of our church facilities. Several suggestions for kitchen improvements, chairlift upgrades and others have been received so far. Have an idea? Let us know your thoughts!

<u>Building Projects:</u> all donations marked 'building projects' are set aside to be used for the next project which takes care of our church property. Everything from lights to flooring to lawn care comes from this fund. <u>Helping Hands</u>: all donations marked 'helping hands' are set aside to be used to help a person in need. This is also used to help the Milan township which uses the fund to help with personal needs.

<u>Food Pantry:</u> all donations marked 'food pantry' are sent to the Milan Food pantry

<u>Office Supplies:</u> all funds marked 'office supplies' are used to buy supplies for our office. This includes paper, envelopes, ink cartridges, etc.

<u>Computer Software:</u> all donations marked 'computer software' are used got support new versions of our required software, our website, and new computers when we need them.
