| Bible Study: The Love of Christ in Our Lives |

| Main Verse: John 3:16                        |

#### Introduction

- Human love is limited, but Christ's love is eternal, perfect, and transforming.
- Opening question: If you could describe Christ's love in one word, what would it be?

#### 1. Christ's Love is Unconditional

#### Verses:

- Romans 5:8 "But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."
- Jeremiah 31:3 "I have loved you with an everlasting love."

### **Discussion questions:**

- 1. What does it mean that Christ loved us while we were still sinners?
- 2. Why do we sometimes think we need to earn God's love?

#### 2. Christ's Love is Sacrificial

#### Verses:

- John 15:13 "Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends."
- Ephesians 5:2 "Christ loved us and gave Himself up for us."

#### **Discussion questions:**

- 1. How is Christ's love different from the love the world offers?
- 2. What sacrifices can we make today to love others like Christ?

#### 3. Christ's Love is Transforming

#### Verses:

- 2 Corinthians 5:17 "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"
- Galatians 2:20 "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me."

#### **Discussion questions:**

- 1. How has Christ's love transformed your personal life?
- 2. What areas of your life still need to be changed by His love?

### 4. Christ's Love is Unbreakable

#### **Verses:**

- Romans 8:38-39 "Nothing... will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord."
- John 10:28-29 "No one will snatch them out of my hand."

### **Discussion questions:**

- 1. What life situations sometimes make us doubt God's love?
- 2. How can we remind ourselves daily that His love is secure and eternal?

#### 5. Christ's Love Calls Us to Love Others

#### Verses:

- John 13:34-35 "By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."
- 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 Love is patient, love is kind...

### **Discussion questions:**

- 1. What does it mean to show Christ's love at home, school, or work?
- 2. What obstacles do we face when trying to love others as Christ commands?

### Conclusion & Challenge

- Christ's love saves us, transforms us, and secures us.
- That same love sends us out to love others.

Final verse: 1 John 4:19 – "We love because He first loved us."

### Weekly Challenge:

- Pray daily thanking God for His love.
- Look for a practical way to show Christ's love this week (forgive someone, help someone, encourage someone).

## **Closing Prayer:**

"Lord, thank You for Your perfect and eternal love. Help us to live each day remembering that nothing can separate us from You. Teach us to love others with the same love You have shown us. In Jesus' name, Amen."
